

Important: Remote Learning Resources:

Change in plans: We originally were planning to have families access the buildings to gather remote learning resources. Those plans have changed. This will be a pick-up, drive-through service starting tomorrow through Friday. There will be a traffic pattern established at each school. Please follow the signs and the instructions from staff. Student learning materials, including items from lockers, have been bagged and tagged by name and grade and will be ready for pick-up tomorrow and Friday. You will be asked your student's name and grade at time of pick-up. The schedule is as follows:
