## 2 STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

3 Students using Shaker Regional School District (SRSD) transportation shall be

- 4 instructed that they are under the jurisdiction of the school from the time they get on the
- 5 bus, until they depart the bus.

## 6 Bus Driver Responsibility

- 7 Students transported in a school bus shall be under the authority of the SRSD and
- 8 under control of the bus driver. The driver of the bus shall be held responsible for the
- 9 orderly conduct of the students transported. Continued disorderly conduct or persistent
- refusal to submit to the authority of the driver shall be sufficient reasons for a student to
- be denied the privilege of transportation in accordance with the rules and procedures of
- the Superintendent.<sup>1</sup>
- The bus driver will have responsibility to maintain orderly behavior of students on school
- buses and will report misconduct to the student's Principal in writing. Video surveillance
- may be used on buses to support the bus driver's reports of unacceptable conduct.

## 16 Principal's Authority

- 17 The School Principal shall have the authority delegated by the Superintendent to
- suspend the riding privileges of students who are disciplinary problems on the bus by
- failing to conform to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Superintendent.
- 20 Parents of children whose pattern of behavior and conduct on school buses endangers
- the health, safety and welfare of other riders will be notified that their children face the
- loss of school bus riding privileges in accordance with the student discipline code.<sup>2</sup>
- Suspensions to continue beyond twenty (20) days must be approved by the Shaker
- 24 Regional School Board (SRSB) (RSA 189:9a).<sup>3</sup>

## 25 Resolution of Conflicts

- A parent who wishes to request a change or exemption from any of the Student
- 27 Transportation rules shall direct that request first to the Superintendent. If the parent is
- 28 not satisfied by the ruling of the Superintendent, he or she may appeal the ruling within
- 29 five days to the SRSB.
- The Superintendent or his/her designee shall publish rules and procedures for conduct
- on buses and these shall be printed in the Parent-Student Handbook.
