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## 2 INSTRUCTIONAL APPROACH1

- 3 Instructional approaches shall be developmentally appropriate and focused on meeting the
- 4 instructional needs of students with different talents, interests, and learning styles.<sup>2</sup>
- 5 The instructional program will include:
  - 1. Procedures for diagnosing learner needs
  - 2. Methods and strategies for teaching that incorporate learner needs
  - 3. Techniques for the evaluation of student outcomes
  - 4. The provision of remedial instruction as needed
- Instruction will also include, where possible, consideration of all available community resources,
- including but not limited to organizations, businesses, talented individuals, natural resources, and
- technology to engage each student in achieving the necessary skill and knowledge.<sup>3</sup>

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- In order to meet the instructional needs of students with different talents, administrators shall
- 15 consider alternative learning programs such as extended learning opportunities, alternative
- learning plans, distance education, and vocational/technical education.

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18 Students will be encouraged to participate in year-round learning.<sup>4</sup>
